




International youth work

One of the basic tasks of all Finnish Youth Centres is to promote peace education and the international activities for young people, as has been the case at Marttinen.

We co-operate extensively with both the European Youth Centres, which have been awarded the Council of Europe Quality Label for Youth Centres, and with an extensive network of European partners working around wide range of topics. In addition, Marttinen is a partner in projects that develop international youth work and and methods for youth work. Cooperation will create policies, events and training to support the growth of children and young people towards responsible and active global citizenship.





Marttinen's international work coordinators **Antti Korhonen** and **Sami Sorjonen** (email: kv@marttinen.fi) guide and help in the twists and turns of internationalisation by providing information, opportunities project advice related to **Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps projects**.

Various Job shadowing and study visits for those working with young people are also under the coordination of Marttinen's international youth work.





Youth exchanges

From couple of days to a couple of weeks, young people (from 13–30 years old) and their leaders can come together to exchange and work on topics that are meaningful for them. Groups from different countries go through the process of designing, communicating, implementing the experience together with the help of Marttinen's tailored support. 
ESC Volunteering

Individuals (18–29 years old) can jump in to an experience of a life time to volunteer and help a cause or organisation they want to support, at the same time learning and living in a different culture. Volunteering activities can from couple of weeks to a full year, working for a wide variety of non-profit organisations, public services and more. Study visits



Job shadows



Canoeing around the island

Marttinen is the island so it's time to paddle around that, through the canal and towards the Herraskoski rapids or or on the lake. With good cooperation with your paddling team, it's usually possible get through the rapids without getting wet. The water and weather conditions affect the choice of route.

Fatbikes

Mountain biking by electric bike NEW in Marttinen. Explore the surrounding area by bike. With the help of the electric assistant, the journey is also folded on steeper uphills. The recommended minimum length for drivers is 165 cm, practically suitable for high school students and older.



Let's go Fishing

Get to know rod-fishing equipment and lures and go fishing at nearby shores or on a boat. In spring, more fishing is done with lures from boats while in autumn the emphasis is on rod-fishing. In winter, ice-fishing is done, when the ice conditions allow. Who will get the biggest catch? In winter, there is a charge for trans-port. The distance from Marttinen is 10 km.

Activities for winter time

Rescue suit floating

Dress on rescue suits and walk on thin ice courageously and safely. How does it feel like when the ice gives way underfoot and you have to get out of the water? We rescue each other by helping our buddies get back on top of the ice and experience what it feels like when we get a buddy on to safe ice again!

Snowshoe hike

Dress the snowshoes and hike in the area around Marttinen to the Toriseva gorge lakes or the Lake Helvetinjärvi National Park. Learning to walk in snowshoes is easy and will allow you to enjoy nature in winter. Differences in height, snowy conditions and the walking speed bring challenges for people with all kinds of challenges and aims. On hikes of over three hours, we make lunch outdoors on the hike.

Log house apartments

Marttinen's log house apartments are a cozy and comfortable accommodation for families and small groups. The apartments with own sauna and terrace.

The apartments are located by Lake Tarjanne, each villa has own terrace.

The apartments have three or four bedrooms with separate beds, a private sauna and a well-equipped living room / kitchen.

Hotel rooms

Youth Centre Marttinen's hotel rooms are located in seperate buildings close to our main building. Youth hotels rooms are for two to six people. The common space of buildings include a living room for spending time together or watching to and a minikitchen for making a cup of evening

· Vihta sauna

Marttinen's Vi<mark>hta Sa</mark>una is a meeting place as a lake landscape surrounded by nature.

The Vihta sauna can host events for up to 40 people. There are two saunas on the premises, both with lake views. There is also a large terrace facing the lake. Meals can be ordered for the sauna from the restaurant Herranen.

Restaurant Herranen

The restaurant Herranen is Marttinen's main restaurant. Most of the youth centre's guests enjoy their breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper in our restaurant located in the main building.

Environmental matters are close to the heart of the restaurant Herranen. There is used Finnish ingredients when it's possible. The used meat and dairy products are Finnish. The restaurant Herranen don't use overfished fish species; instead, they use the pike perch and perch from local waters.
